Students who entered Rowan University prior to Fall 2024 should follow the guide for their program and start year in consultation with their advisor.

Master of Professional Studies Requirements for Graduation

- Students must complete at least 30 semester hours (sh) of coursework that apply to their Rowan University degree.
- Students must have a cumulative GPA of at least 2.75 in Rowan University coursework. (Transfer courses/credit do not count toward the RU GPA.)

The Master of Professional Studies (M.P.S.) with the COGS in Administrative Science will provide students with the organizational, leadership and analytical skills needed to secure stable administrative positions in a wide variety of industries. The program is comprised of a core curriculum of vital strategies in project management, teambuilding and analytics coupled with a focus on this area by applying the 15-credit COGS in Administrative Science. Studies are finalized with an application of skills in an action study course. Students who graduate from this program will be prepared to move forward within their field or transition to a new one by demonstrating in-depth analytical competencies, leadership skills, and the communication of viable solutions.
